

# Maricopa Homelessness Data Report

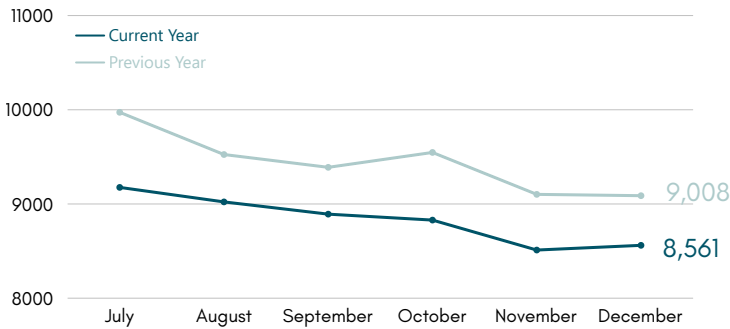
## Monthly Snapshot: December 2025

### Who is active in our system?

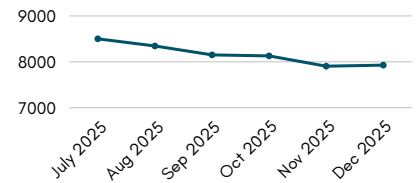
#### Total Actively Homeless Households



These are the households using homelessness services in Maricopa County and is equivalent to those on the local By-Name List.

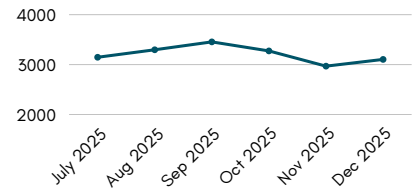

#### Monthly Takeaway

December saw a slight uptick compared to the downward trend in overall active households of the last 6 months. There remains an increase in the households leaving homelessness to stay with family and friends. 1 Youth-specific transitional housing project opened this month and no projects closed.
